David Baldacci

David Baldacci is a successful novelist who has written 19 full-length novels in addition to seven screenplays, essays, and short stories. His books are published worldwide in at least 45 different languages, with over 90 million copies of his books appearing in print. Mr. Baldacci's novels cover themes as diverse and contemporary as coming of age in *Wish You Well*, the power of global markets in *Total Control*, the expertise of special ops teams in *Last Man Standing*, and the hidden treasures and perils of the nation's clandestine intelligence services in *Simple Genius*. Mr. Baldacci is involved in several philanthropic efforts. His greatest efforts are dedicated to his family's own Wish You Well Foundation, which supports family literacy in the United States by fostering and promoting the development and expansion of new and existing literacy and educational programs.

Mr. Baldacci serves as a national ambassador for the National Multiple Sclerosis Society, and participates in numerous charities, including the Barbara Bush Foundation for Family Literacy, the American Cancer Society, and the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation.

Mr. Baldacci earned a degree from the University's School of Law in 1986 before practicing trial and corporate law for nine years.
